

The son who is Faithful:

2 Timothy 2:11-13

[11] The saying is trustworthy, for:

If we have died with him, we will also live with him;

[12] if we endure, we will also reign with him;

if we deny him, he also will deny us;

[13] if we are faithless, he remains faithful—

for he cannot deny himself.

Points:

- One Jesus Faithfulness in Salvation (meaning he is faithful in saving us (V11-12a))
- second, Jesus Faithfulness in Judgement (Meaning he is faithful in being Just) (12b-13)

Main Idea: The faithfulness of the son, gives us assurance and adoration.

Point 1: Jesus faithfulness in salvation

- Romans 5:8 says “ but God shows his love for us, that while we were still
- Romans 6: 5-7
- 5 For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we shall certainly be united with him in a resurrection like his. 6 We know that our old self was crucified with him in order that the body of sin might be brought to nothing, so that we would no longer be enslaved to sin. 7 For one who has died has been set free from sin.
- John 16:33
- [33] I have said these things to you, that in me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world.”

Point Two: Jesus Faithfulness in Judgement

Matthew 10:33

“But whoever denies me before men, I will also deny him before my father who is in heaven.”

Romans 9:3

[3] For I could wish that I myself were accursed and cut off from Christ for the sake of my brothers, my kinsmen according to the flesh.

Malachi 1:6-7 it says “A son honors his father, and a servant his master. If then I am a father, where is my honor?. Says the Lord of Host to you, o priest, who despise my name. But you say, “how have we despised your name? Verse 7 By offering polluted food upon my altar....”

How has God been faithful?:

1. His faithfulness has brought forth the promised savior and redeemer. **John 1:26-27** [26] John answered them, “I baptize with water, but among you stands one you do not know, [27] even he who comes after me, the strap of whose sandal I am not worthy to untie.”
2. His faithfulness has given us a high priest who is our mediator between the father and us. **Hebrews 4:14-15** [14] Since then we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus, the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. [15] For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin.
3. His Faithfulness was demonstrated by the obedience of his death on the cross. **Romans 5:18-19** [18] Therefore, as one trespass led to condemnation for all men, so one act of righteousness leads to justification and life for all men. [19] For as by the one man’s disobedience the many were made sinners, so by the one man’s obedience the many will be made righteous.
4. His Faithfulness will be fully seen in the glorious day of the final Judgment. **2 Timothy 2:13** “ if we are faithless, he remains Faithful for he cannot deny himself.

2 Peter 3:9

[9] The Lord is not slow to fulfill his promise as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing that any should perish, but that all should reach repentance.
